Choosing Defenders

1. Checks existing Requests and Reservations in Queue Order.
2. Is still conditional.
3. Holds capacity on one or more constrained flowgates or paths needed by the Challenger.
4. If a Tier 2 and Challenger is Tier 1,
 1. If Pending – Move to A-List
 2. If Confirmed – Move to B-List
5. If same Tier
 1. If Pending and a shorter Duration – Move to A-List.
 2. If Confirmed and a shorter Duration – Move to C-List
6. Sort all lists by priority (Increment, Duration, Queue-time)
7. Work the A-List first Superseding what is needed.
8. If there are still constrained paths, Work the B-List or C-List Recalling what is needed until there are no more defenders or Challenger is satisfied.
9. C-List Defenders get ROFR
