



Transmission Services Standard Performance Metrics

Reporting period April 1, 2009 - June 30, 2009

The following metrics are reported in compliance with the Standard Performance Metrics required by Title 18 CFR, Part 37.6(h).

Performance Metrics

BPA Transmission Services completed no Study Agreements and issued no reports during the first quarter.

On June 1, 2009 BPA Transmission Services (BPA-TS) conducted its second Network Open Season for transmission paths internal to the network. During Network Open Season (NOS), Transmission Services will offer Precedent Transmission Service Agreements (PTSA's) to all customers with transmission service requests (TSR's) already in the transmission queue and to all customers that submitted new TSR's between June 1, 2009 and July 1, 2009 for service over Bonneville's internal transmission network. BPA-TS has received a total of 98 NOS requests. The Network Open Season excluded TSR's for service over the interties.

Transmission Services is evaluating those requests. Transmission Services will conduct a cluster study with a projected completion of December 31, 2009. In FY 2009, BPA-TS is also scoping what an Intertie Open Season would look like to cover all those TSR's excluded from the 2008 and 2009 NOS.

TSR's submitted after July 1, 2009 for service over the internal network, will be included in the 2010 Network Open Season scheduled for June 2010. Transmission Services will conduct a cluster study for these and all other TSR's that are submitted before the close of the 2010 Network Open Season.

During the Network Open Season, Transmission Services has not issued new SIS or SFS agreements or studies for external paths. Network Open Season guidelines and principles are being considered for these external paths as well.
