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- A. Footnote 3 to the table in A.4. should be deleted. The "Id." In footnote 3 does not make sense when considering Network Load Transfer and is in conflict with section B, Advance Payment for Technical Studies.

### Transmission Service's Response

BPA will remove the "Network Load Transfer" category from the table in section A.4, including Footnote 3. The concept of "Network Load Transfer" is redundant in the context of the table in section A.4.

Under the Business Practice, "load growth" is defined as "load added to an existing NT Customer's system as a result of increased customer load or transfer of load from another NT Customer." This definition of the term "load growth" encompasses the concept of "Network Load Transfer" which is defined as "transfer of load from one NT Customer to another NT Customer." Because the term "load growth" covers the scenario of Network Load Transfer, BPA will remove the "Network Load Transfer" category from the table in section A.4.
