1. PNGC Power

We want to be sure that the customer can submit a remainder TSR with the original queue if partial service is accepted. We suggest the following language in blue below.

Version 26 proposed language

C.4. If the Customer wants to be considered for offers of Partial Service between 6 - 11 months in duration for a long-term TSR, the Customer must specify the minimum amount of capacity it is willing to accept in the Customer Comment field of the TSR. If the Customer does not specify an amount, BPA Transmission Services will not consider the TSR for offers of Partial Service between 6 -11 months in duration. If the Customer specifies an amount and BPA Transmission Services is able to make an offer equal to or exceeding that amount, the customer must accept the offer or its TSR will be removed from the queue. If the Customer accepts the Partial Service offer, the Customer may submit a remainder TSR in accordance with section C. 2, Submitting Remainder TSR, of the Partial Service Business Practice.

Transmission Service's Response

BPA appreciates PNGC's participation and feedback in reviewing the proposed revisions to Partial Long-Term Firm Business Practice. The final Requesting Transmission Service Business Practice will include the following language:

If the Customer accepts the Partial Service offer, the Customer may submit a remainder TSR in accordance with the Partial Long-Term Firm Service Business Practice.
